Please notice that this year the HTSF Conference dedicates a **special session** on **sustainable business models (SBM)** organized by the Collaborative Business Models for Inclusive Business (CBM4IB) project (see for more information: [www.inclusivecollaboration.nl](http://www.inclusivecollaboration.nl)).
